Christy Filgate provided updates on:

- **Staffing update**: Amanda Dorsch has taken a new position in Redwater. Tom McGrath accepted the position of Math Grades 7-12. Amber Poliquin was moved from LC (Math/Science) to SPVA to teach Science 7-9.
- Facility Update: Stand up desks have been purchased for all staff
- Technology update:
  - Google Classroom upgrade to allow for break out rooms/polls, private conversations for teachers to have with students.
  - Looked into options for KAMI. Staff presented a solid argument for KAMI this year
  - Options for Successmaker? IXL?- Successmaker has been committed to for this year and comes with a support person (Tom Emerson), where IXL does not. Will reevaluate at the end of the year the success of this added program.
  - Survey result: Interest in attending events. 20 surveys came back re: a field trip to the Outdoor Classroom. 17 were interested. Clear indicator of wanting to attend activities. New committee created to oversee monthly activities for LC and SPVA students.
