### School Trustee Report: Trustee Oatway-Mclay

- Dispute re: Lagoon, the court has dismissed claims. Good news- dismissed, Bad news cost \$700,000. SPS can apply for legal costs. The division will be submitting this claim
- Going to undertake value scope project- what are the division top priories- Gibbons school #1, Most schools are 50 years+ old. Ecole Morinville Public- Also in need of something Sturgeon Heights-Needs modernization; Celebrated 50 years as well. Redwater is 4<sup>th</sup>, Landing Trail is 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Value scoping: senior admin, mayors/ counselors, stake-holders from AB ed. 2-day gathering to gather feedback in community and in-house regarding what they would like to see.
- COSC coming: amazing opportunity to talk to others in the division- SPVA represent?
- SPS values stakeholders- working hard on relationships and transparency, including the Advocacy committee- another way to stay connected to the community SPVA and LC.
- Transportation: Schoolboards are 95% funded by government. Gave us a budget and we are constantly in a deficit; trying to balance the budget (trip time, 2.4 km boundary) Looking at ways to fix this: could be a choice ridership, advocating to provincial govt to fund model and look at 2.4 km rule.
- Board Chair and Superintendent- met with Minister of Ed- Minister indicated they would be addressing transportation in terms of education.
- HEPA filter- almost complete- does SPVA get this? Not sure. Will ask and get back to us.

- Military base update: Visited the Family Resource Centre and spoke about the opportunities the Learning Centres can provide students under 20 years, and for adults wishing to upgrade. Left SPS sign to place in the FRC.
- Field Trip-Outdoor Classroom: Fantastic feedback from both students and parents. Grant \$ allowed students to take the bus to and from.
