Math with Mr. Kaya! Math 5/6

In April, grade 5 and 6 students completed the Geometry and Measurement unit.

Students learned:


- · Name and sort triangles according to numbers of equal sides and equal angles
- Name and sort triangles by types of angles
- Construct a specified triangle
- Compare side and angle measurements in regular and irregular triangles
- Demonstrate congruence in regular polygons by superimposing and measuring
- Interpret and problem and select an appropriate strategy
- Develop and apply formulas to determine the perimeter of polygons
- Develop and apply formula to determine the area of a rectangle
- Develop and apply formula to determine the volume of a rectangular prism

Math 7

In April, grade 7 students completed the **Equations unit.**

Grade 7 Students demonstrated and used the preservation of equality with equations. Students explained the difference between an equation and an expression. Students used models, pictures and symbols to solve and verify solutions of equations. Students solved equations using algebra. Students made decisions about which method to use to solve equations. Students solved problems using related


equations.






Math with Ms. Savin!

In April grade 8 and 9 have been working on their Shape and Space unit:



Grade 8 students have finished up rotations, translations and reflections and just completed their quiz on surface area of prisms and cylinders.

Grade 9 students have finished scale factor and rotational symmetry.





LA/Social/PE/Health/Music with Ms. Senych!

In LA 5-7 we are completing our Poetry Unit and perfecting our Narrative Writing skills!

In Social 5 and 6 we are working on News Article Writing and in Social 7 we are working on Fight, Flight and the British Rule!

In Health 5-7 we are finishing up our Financial Literacy Unit. In the next few weeks we will be starting our Puberty Unit so please see your email for more information regarding consent for your child to learn the topics covered in this Unit.









Social 8/9 with Ms. Waller!

In Social 8, we have completed our Aztec/Spanish unit and have begun learning about Japan. We are beginning to explore the Edo period and how Japan pursued a policy of isolation.

In Social 9, we are currently studying consumerism and how advertising and marketing can impact our quality of life.

As the provincial election is a few weeks away, we will be talking about elections and party platforms periodically this month.







Science with Ms. Poliquin!

Science 5: We completed our Classroom Chemistry Unit and started our final unit, Weather. We are working on tracking the weather and learning about differences between weather and climate.

Science 6: We finished Flight and are working on Air and Aerodynamics. We will move in mid-month to our final unit, Evidence and Investigation.

Science 7: We are working on Planet Earth. Students are completing a game based version of the unit where they are completing tasks and boss battles to learn about Planet Earth.







Science 8: We are completing our final unit, Fresh and Saltwater Systems. Students are completing a game based version of the unit where they created a character, and complete Tasks and Battles to learn the main concepts of the unit.

Science 9: We completed Electricity and have moved on to our final unit, Space and Space Exploration.



All diploma exam except those that are asterisked (*) remain SECURED after the administration and returned to Alberta Education.


